Opportunities for Physicians

Are you getting burned out? Does going to work every day and seeing the same patient over and over again (with different faces and names) make you dread clinic? If so, do I have a deal for you! One of the greatest ways to breathe life into your practice of medicine is to follow the Great Master Hippocrates and "impart the knowledge of the Art" to others. The Baylor University Pre-Medical Department has many opportunities for you to get involved which include hosting shadowers, speaking engagements and teaching pre-med students.

The Baylor University Pre-Medical Practicum (BU-MPP) Program is a great way to get involved. BU-MPP pre-med students are enrolled in a class that teaches them the ins-and-outs of shadowing and clinic operations, and gets them connected for shadowing with physicians in our community. Students arrive to your clinic dressed in a BU-MPP branded polo shirt and khakis, ready to silently observe and learn on their way to becoming physicians. This program enrolls only competitively-selected students, so you can be sure your valuable clinic time is not being wasted.



89th Legislative Session and Advocacy

the Texas Medicine Today emails. Reach out to get signed up if you are not. Please take time to read each section regarding the legislative session. When needed, calls to action will be requested and a simple link will be provided to drop in your name, TMA/medical related commentary and your own additional comments if warranted. These will be in the TMA Grassroots Action Center under Legislative Action Alerts. Our legislators pay attention to these emails as they are sent directly to their office through the state's website. As we engage our elected representatives, remind them that we are the party of medicine, and we try as best we can, not to be a "Red" or a "Blue" issue. We are trying to propagate what is in the best care of our patients, Texans. See attached details.
